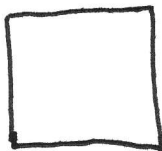
Supplies Needed:

1 **solid color** 10" square - Bold is great!

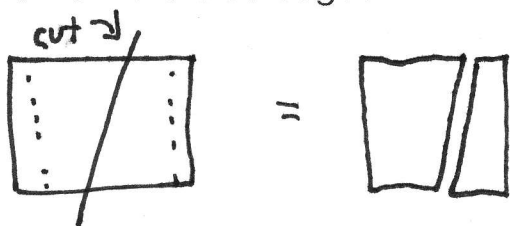
1-1/2" **solid black strip** that is long enough to go through your 10" square  
(Cut 12"-14" to be sure.)

**Instructions:**

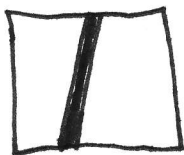
**Step 1:** Cut one 10" block out of any solid color.  
(no designs/no color on color)



**Step 2:** Make a straight cut on an angle through your block at least 2" or more from the side edges.



**Step 3:** Sew the 1-1/2 solid black strip where you have made your cut to sew the block back together.



*If you make more than 1 block,  
make your cuts in other directions.*

**Step 4: Square up to 9-1/2 inches**

Now, wasn't that easy?

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
