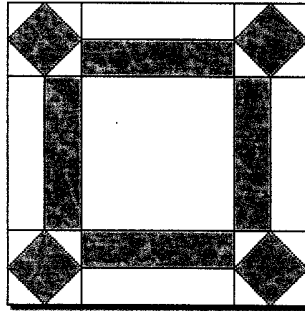


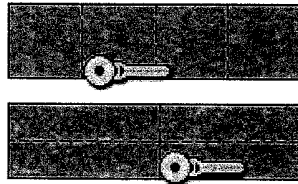
Johnny Around the Corner

This makes a 12" block !

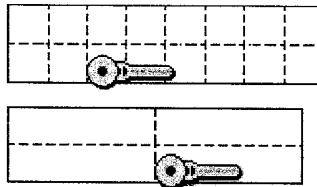

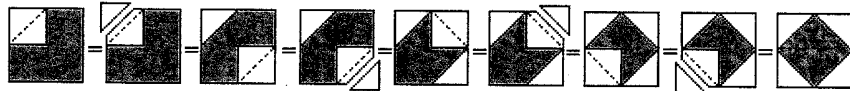
** Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block **



Start by cutting the Color 1 3-1/2" x 14" strip into four 3-1/2" squares. Then cut the Color 1 4" x 13" strip into four 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles...



Next cut the Color 2 4" x 16" strip into sixteen 2" squares. Now cut the Color 2 4" x 13" strip into four 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles...



To sew the block's corner units place a Color 2 2" square right sides together atop the top left corner of a Color 1 3-1/2" square, with outer edges aligned. On the back of the top square, lightly draw the diagonal, then sew ON this diagonal line. Cut off the excess seam allowance, and press the remainder towards the outer triangle. Repeat this with another Color 2 square on the opposing corner, and then on the two adjacent corners. Make four units like this. These should measure 3-1/2"... on to Page 2!

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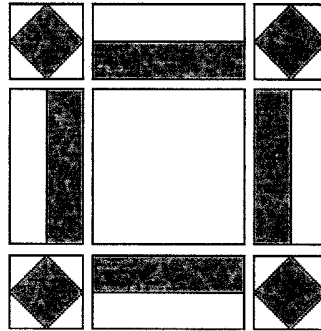
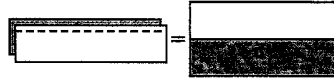

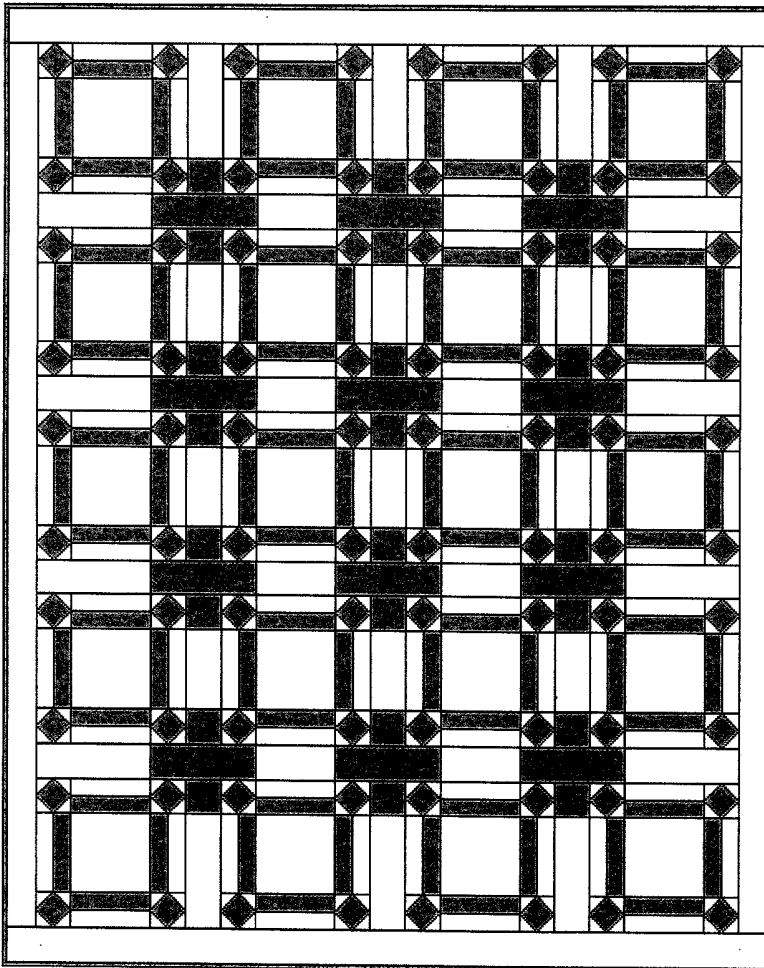

Johnny Around the Corner - Page 2

Next we'll sew together the side units, by sewing a Color 1 and a Color 2 2" x 6-1/2" rectangle together along one long edge, using a scant 1/4" seam. Press seam to the darker side. Make four units like this. These should each measure 3-1/2" x 6-1/2"...



Now lay out all of the block's units as shown at left, with the Color 2 6-1/2" square as the center unit. Sew three horizontal rows, and then join the rows to finish up your Johnny Around the Corner block!

Color 1 needs: one 3-1/2" x 14" strip AND one 4" x 13" strip



Color 2

Color 2 needs: one 6-1/2" square AND one 4" x 16" strip AND one 4" x 13" strip
