Wrap The World With Quilts is a 501(c)(3) Public Charity based in Lehi, Utah. In March, 2022 Beth Hawkins and Gina Halladay along with Gina's husband Hal, started the **Wrap Ukraine With Quilts** (WUWQ) drive to send comfort quilts to Ukraine refugees. The drive became so large, they decided to create an official non-profit organization called Wrap The World With Quilts.

[HelloCottons.com](https://www.hellocottons.com) is the website of Beth Hawkins and Gina Halladay who are using it to register quilt donations and accept monetary donations for the Wrap Ukraine With Quilts drive.

Donate a Quilt - Register your quilt on the site and get a QR code to attach to the quilt. The QR code gives the recipient an opportunity to send a thank you note to the quilt sender.

Send up to 50 lbs of quilts for \$20 with their WUWQ [GiveBackBox](#) label. There's a button on the front page to link to Give Back Box to purchase the label (see below).

Donate Money on the site to help with shipping costs on the website.

[GoFundMe](#) to Adopt A Sewing Machine was a fund raiser to help with costs of the Sewing Rooms established by WUWQ in Katowice and Krakow. Beth, Gina, and Hal along with 30+ volunteers went to Poland to teach refugees sewing skills so that they could make small items to sell, and get out of the shelter into an apartment.

Lifting Hands International

[LiftingHandsInternational](#) is an international relief organization located in Utah. They are active in Ukraine, Poland, and Moldova. Their cargo planes fly every 3-4 weeks. They transport most of the WUWQ quilts. Donate \$ on their site.

Give Back Box

[GiveBackBox](#) is a non-profit organization that helps you donate goods to charities with minimal shipping costs. They are also collecting goods to send to Ukraine refugees. Donate \$ directly on their site.
