## EASY SHOO FLY BLOCK

Use three (3) additional fabrics from your stash that compliment the provided fabric square.

## CUTTING:

$$
\begin{aligned}
& \mathrm{A}=2 \text { squares } 43 / 8^{\prime \prime} \\
& \mathrm{B}=4 \text { squares } 4 " \\
& \mathrm{C}=2 \text { squares } 43 / 8^{\prime \prime} \\
& \mathrm{D}=\text { provided fabric } 4 " \text { square for center of block }
\end{aligned}
$$

Draw a diagonal line (corner to corner) on backside of squares "A". Place squares "A" on top of squares "C" (right sides together). Sew scant $1 / 4$ " seam on both sides of drawn line. Cut on solid drawn line, press. Makes four 4" square units.


Assemble block as shown.


Block should measure 11"
