# Block of the Xoonth ~ Xay / June 2011 Tulip 

1) Dark color on color
A. Cut one 2" square
2) White on White
B. Cut one 3.5 " square
C. Cut one $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square
D. Cut one 2 " square
E. Cut one 2 " x 3.5 " rectangle
3) Light or pastel contrasting color to dark color
F. Cut one $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square
G. Cut one 3.5 " $\times 6.5$ " rectangle

## Construct Tulip Block

## Triangle square Unit

Take the $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares ( C and F ) and cut each on the diagonal.

You will need only one block. Sew right sides together and press open, forming a block as follows:


## Diagonal Seam Unit

Take the 3.5 " square (B) and set on top at one end of the 3.5 " $\times 6.5$ " rectangle ( G ), right sides together.

Stitch across (B) diagonally from corner to corner.
Trim 1/4" beyond the seam and press open.
