From fabric \#1, red or predominately red with white print, cut four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and cut one $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1 / 2 "}{}$ rectangle

From a coordinating fabric \#2, red with white print,
cut four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and cut one $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle

From fabric \#3, white with red heart fabric,
cut one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square
From fabric \#4 white or white on white background fabric, cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square and cut two $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares

| Row 1: Sew $21 / 2{ }^{1 / \prime}$ squares \#1, \#2, \#1 together to make a strip |  |
