# Block of the Month ~ March / April 2012 Pinwheel in the Box 

Makes a 12.5 " block (12" finished)

## Color 1- White on White

口 From one $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ strip, cross-cut eight $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## Color 2-Any Bright Color

From one $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ strip, cross-cut eight $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## Construction

$\square$ On the back of each white square, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner
$\square$ Pair up one white on white square with one bright color square and pin.
$\square$ Sew a seam $1 / 4$ " from both sides of the marked line
$\square$ Cut the square in two along the previously marked line and press towards the bright fabric
$\square$ Repeat to make sixteen half square triangles
$\square$ Follow the arrangement in the diagram below to construct the block pressing the seams of each row in alternate directions as shown by the arrows so that they neatly nest
