## Block of the Xonth ~ November 2012 A Plain Old Nine Patch



1. Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 221 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip of fabric \#1 into five $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
2. Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18 "$ strip of fabric \#2 into four 4 $1 / 2^{\prime}$ squares.

3. Lay out squares as shown to the left. Sew three horizontal rows of squares using a scant $1 / 4$ " seam. Press seams to darker fabric.
4. Join columns as indicated to complete the block. Final block measurements are $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
