## Block of the Month ~ February 2013

Nine-Patch Heart Block<br>McCallsQuilting.com

Finished size: $71 / 2 " \times 71 / 2$ " (Use white for background, red or pink for the heart portion)

## Cutting:

White background:
1 square $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
4 squares 2" x 2 "
Print One:
1 rectangle $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ "
5 squares 2 " x 2 "
Print Two:
1 rectangle $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ "
4 squares 2 " x 2 "


## Piecing the Block:

Draw diagonal line on wrong side of white print 2 " squares.
Refer to diagram 1A placed marked square on a Print One rectangle, right sides together aligning raw edges. Stitch on drawn line, trim 1/4" away. Open and press. Repeat on opposite side. Make 1. Repeat with Print Two making 1.

Stitch five Print One 2" squares and four Print Two 2" squares together as show to make a nine patch.
Referring to Diagram III, sew block pieces together.
