

Jelly Roll Quilt Block
Block size: Finished 8" / unfinished $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cutting:
From Dark Scraps:
Cut 2 - $8^{1 / 2} \times 21 / 2$
Cut 2-3 $1 / 2 \times 21 / 2$
Cut 1-2 $1 / 2 \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ square
From Light (I used muslin, but any light fabric is ok - just make sure there is contrast):
Cut 4-2 $1 / 2 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$
Cut 2-4 $1 / 2 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$

Sewing:
Step 1: Sew light $11 / 2 \times 21 / 2$ strips to each side of $21 / 2$ dark square. Press seams away from center.
Step 2: Sew light $41 / 2 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips to remaining two sides. Press seams away from center.
Step 3: Sew a $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ light strip to one of the short edges on each of the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ dark strips. Press to dark.

Step 4: Sew these two unites to the top and bottom of the center piece, ensuring that the light edging is at the top on one side and the bottom on the other. Press toward dark.

Step 5: Sew dark $81 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ " strips to either side. Press to dark.
