
Scrappy Susannah quilt block

You'll need:

8 (3.5") print squares*
4 (3.5") white or background squares
2 (4.25") print squares*
2 (4.25") white or background squares

*for a scrappy look, use a different print for each of the 3.5" and 4.25" squares!



Makes one 12.5" quilt block

- 1. On the two (4.25") white squares, draw a diagonal line or fold in half and finger press.
- 2. Place each 4.25" white square right sides together with a 4.25" print square. Sew about 1/4" away from the line, on both sides of the drawn line.








3. Cut along the drawn line to make two half square triangles (HST).



4. Open HSTs, press seam allowance away from the white, and trim each HST to be 3.5" square.



5. Layout squares as shown.



- 6. Using a 1/4" seam, sew squares into rows. Press each row. Pressing seams open is recommended.
- 7. Sew rows together, matching seams, and press block. Block should measure 12.5" square.
